

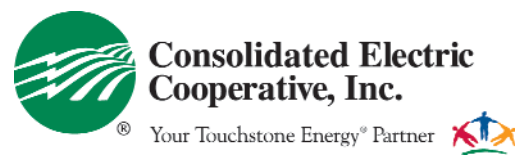

Controlling the high demand for electric during times of weather extremes can help Consolidated Electric continue to keep electric rates low for members. Electric demand is typically high on bitterly cold winter days and very hot and humid summer days. The installation of a radio control switch on your electric water heater can help the Co-op decrease the electric load for a few hours, when it's most critical.

The water heater rebate program offers a cash rebate for installation of an electric water heater and a radio control switch. To qualify, members need to sign an agreement to retain the radio control switch on their water heater for a minimum of one year. Other restrictions may apply. We recommend you call us before purchasing your water heater to discuss the incentive amount for which you may qualify.

In addition, you could be eligible for up to \$24 a year in credits on your electric bill if you use more than 750 kilowatt hours of electricity each month and retain the radio control switch on your water heater.



Program Guidelines

\$200	50-70	11 years or more ⁽¹⁾	
\$300	71 or more	6-10 years	
\$400	71 or more	11 years or more ⁽¹⁾	
\$150			Bonus if your new electric water heater replaces a gas or oil water heater ⁽²⁾

Important Note: All water heaters must have no larger than a 4,500-watt element size.

(1) Must have minimum two inches of foam installation (R-16 value).

(2) Consolidated Electric must confirm the existence of the gas or oil water heater before it is removed from your property.
