2012 CONSOLIDATED ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE SCHOLARSHIP

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

To be eligible for the Consolidated Electric Cooperative awards, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants.

1. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper* vocational or technical school entrance.
2. Any applicant who has received a full tuition scholarship to the school of his/her choice is not eligible for a scholarship from OREC.
3. Applicants must be a son, daughter or legal ward of a Consolidated Electric Cooperative member living on the lines. They must be receiving service at the time of the statewide competition.
4. Applicants in both divisions must have a current career average of "B" or better {3 pt. on 4 pt. system} and be accepted and then enrolled when they receive the award in the accredited college or proper* vocational/technical school of student's choice. Applicants in both divisions accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible applicants.
5. Members of the immediate families and persons residing in the households of trustees, managers, distribution cooperative employees and OREC or affiliated organization employees are not eligible to participate in the competition.
6. Applications are due to our office by Feb 21, 2012.
7. Final applicants must be available for scheduled interviews.

* Proper vocational or technical school means one beyond high school where credits can be transferred to a state accredited four-year college.

Application information must be confined to the official nomination form with no attachments other than grade transcripts. Transcripts should include the 1st semester of their senior year.
